#### CAMP DIRECTORS

#### JEEF HOSLES

In five seasons with the Lakers, Hosler has led GVSU to two NCAA Division II National Championships and posted an 113-10-5 overall record. The Lakers also claimed its 14 th straight GLIAC regular season title and won the GLIAC Tournament for the 12 th year in a row. Before taking over at GVSU, Hosler spent eight seasons in the NCAA DIII ranks at Alma College. Under his watch, the Scots amassed a 91-55-12 overall record, won their first-ever Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association (MIAA) regular season title in 2010 and was the only team in the league to finish third or better each of the final six years. He holds a United States Soccer Federation (USSF) National "B" License and USYSA National "Youth" License.

#### KRISTEN WAI KEE

Walker has spent the last five seasons on staff with the Lakers, helping lead the most successful soccer program in Division II history to its tenth straight Midwest Regional Championship and Elite 8 appearance before falling in the National Championship game in 2018. Prior to her return to Allendale, Walker spent two seasons in the NAIA ranks at Davenport University as an assistant. During her time with the Panthers, they went 36-6-2 overall and were 16-1-0 in Wolverine-Hoosier Athletic Conference matches, winning back-to-back WHAC Tournament and regular season titles. She holds a United States Soccer Federation (USSF) National "C" License.

# **GOALKEEPER PROGRAM**

This is a daily training program for part-time and full-time goalkeepers. Our coaching staff will work with goalkeepers on specific technical and tactical ideas along with conditioning drills and exercises. All areas of goalkeeper training are covered including: shot saving, distribution, handling air balls, one-on-one scenarios, controlling the penalty area, and communication from the back. All participants will train with both their designated team for the week as well as receive extra position specific goalkeeper training.

#### FLITE CAMP I JULY 7 – INTH

WHO: Girls Entering Grades 5th-12th, 2019

WHEN: July 7-10th, Sunday-Wednesday

COST: Grades 10-12: Resident Rate= \$425 Commuter Rate= \$355

Grades 5-9: Resident Rate= \$395 Commuter Rate= \$325

(All campers receive a GVSU soccer ball)

Elite Camp I, July 8-11th, provides 10-12th graders with a very competitive, fun, and educational environment while gaining college exposure and professional coaching. 5-7th and 8-9th graders will follow a similar schedule through out the week, receiving intensive instruction on the technical and tactical aspect of the game preparing them for the next level. Players have the option for an additional \$50 to participate in 2 extra hours of non-contact more intensive skill work for one hour on Monday and Tuesday. The design of this camp will involve training and games. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be provided to all resident campers (lunch and dinner to all commuters). The players will be provided multiple sessions Sunday-Wednesday (weather permitting). Sessions are considered to be either games or training. A tentative schedule will be given to campers at check-in.

#### FLITE CAMP II JULY 24TH - 26TH

WHO: Boys and Girls Entering Grades 5th-9th, 2019

WHEN: July 24-26th, Wednesday-Friday

(All campers receive a GVSU soccer ball)

We are excited to announce our Elite Camp II for boys and girls entering grades 5th-9th. This camp provides campers of all levels with fun instruction on the technical and tactical aspects of the game in age appropriate training groups. Emphasis will be placed on the fundamental skills needed to promote individual development and growth. All players have the option for an additional \$50 to participate in 2 extra hours of non-contact more intensive skill work for one hour on Thursday and Friday. The design of this camp will involve training and games. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be provided to all resident campers (Junch and dinner to all commuters). The players will be provided multiple sessions Wednesday-Friday (weather permitting). Sessions are considered to be either games or training. A tentative schedule will be given to campers at check-in.

In the older age groups, campers will also be challenged in the tactical areas of the game. Players will be grouped based on age, level, and skill to ensure a proper learning environment. Also included every day is 1 hour at the GVSU indoor pool. If players need an early drop off, supervision will begin at 8:30am for an additional \$25.00.
